**Style: Guide for Contributors**

In order to simplify and review articles and to publish the Journal regularly, all contributors who wish to print their articles in this Journal are requested to observe the following guidelines:

1. Articles should be research-oriented (review and translated articles will not be accepted at all).
2. All articles should consist of the following parts:  
The Persian as well as English title, abstract (200–250 words equaling to 15 lines), key words, introduction, body of the article, results and references.
3. The title of article should be short and expressive.
4. Name(s) of the author(s) in Persian and English, the scientific rank and affiliation of the author(s) in Persian and English, full address of the author in charge of correspondences including: postal address, phone number, fax number, as well as e-mail address in Persian and English should all be mentioned.
5. The history of the research-topic should be mentioned in the introduction.
6. The synonyms of technical terms in foreign language should be mentioned at footnotes.
7. Maps, figures, tables, charts and graphs/diagrams should be printed on separate sheets. They should be numerically given in the order of use in the bibliography.
8. Pictures should be exact, clear and original.
9. All the papers should be numbered and the maximum length of an article should not exceed 30 pages.

10–1. Within the body of the article:

References are cited with parentheses including the number of the appropriate source within the alphabetical reference list followed by page numbers. Example: (2:38).

Moreover, synonyms of technical terms should be mentioned in Arabic, English or other languages concerned at footnotes. If the surname of two or more writers are the same, it is necessary that their names should be successively mentioned, and also, if the writer has several articles in one year, in order to specify the order of the publication, the Persian alphabets should be used for Persian sources and English alphabets for foreign ones.

10–2. In the end of article:

10–2–1. Books:

Family name, name of author(s), title of the book, number of volumes, name of the translator, publisher, place of publication, year of publication.

10-2-2. Journals:

Family name, name of author(s), title of the article, title and number of the Journal, year of publication, and whole number of article pages.

11. Articles extracted from Ph.D thesis will be accepted for review only if the thesis adviser accepts the responsibility for the article.

12. If the research was financially supported by an institute, the title of that institute should be printed on the first page.

13. No article should have been previously published in another journal, or in the proceedings of scientific conferences and gatherings, nor should have they been simultaneously submitted for publication to other journals.

14. Four copies of the article together with a diskette under Word software should be submitted to the Literature and Humanity Journal Bureau by the author(s), personally, and must observe the following format: articles should be printed on A4 paper; one-sided, 1.5cm line spacing, preferably using Lotus Font, size 13.

15. Authors will be held responsible for the truth or falsity of the content of the articles.

16. The editors of the Journal maintain the right to accept or reject, and to edit the articles. Received articles will not be returned.

17. Should the article be published, 3 copies of the Journal will be dedicated to each author.
